



Chap Measuring Chart

For best results, take measurements at the following points.

The measuring tape should fit snugly but not tightly

so that the chaps will not bind.

A. WAIST - at the position where the chap belt will be worn, measure completely around the waist.

B. OUTSEAM - from a point at the top of the belt (front edge of the hipbone) to the bottom of the chaps.

C. INSEAM - from the crotch to the bottom of the chaps.

D. THIGH - circumference at the thickest point.

E. MIDDLE THIGH - circumference at the thigh half-way between the knee and the crotch.

F. ABOVE KNEE - circumference of the leg 1" above the knee
